

37% + of the total class hours taught were conducted by full-time and part-time faculty, and with associates at a professional level.





+ The Campuses get strengthened with an Academic Affairs Department




+ The search process for the Vice President of Academic Affairs gave us the designation of Dr. Esther Mulnix.








INTERNATIONAL ACCREDITATION


