

Parting from the training process and the four fields of the educational model [6], extra-curricular programs are developed.

Among these programs, the following outstand:

1. Entrepreneurs[17],
Objective: Students understand the importance and acquire the skills to establish personal projects in their daily tasks so they can strengthen self-employment.
2. Academic Exchange programs [18],
Objective: Students immerse, not only in the education of other universities, but in other nation's culture.
3. Learning English,
Objective: Students speak and practice English so by the time they finish their major, they can express fluently in this language.
4. Professional Practices [21],
Objective: Students will make a link with the production, service or government sectors, in order to apply what was learned in their major.
5. Social Service[22],
Objective: Students will have a link with civil society or government departments in order to provide their knowledge at the service of society.
6. Symposiums, congresses
Objective: Students organize, promote, and contact lecturers to participate in symposiums in order to exercise their leadership capacity for the student community and strengthening of their major.
7. Prom Queen, student society
Objective: The Student Community participates in events that strengthen their civic spirit, so the committee participants apply their leadership and capability to manage projects that strengthen student life.
8. Science Week, engineering week, among others.
Objective: Students will organize exhibitions, conferences or other means for the rest of the CETYS community in order to let them know about their major and to develop their organization and leadership skills.
