Values, interests, beliefs, freedom, imagination, creativity, historic memory, hope...



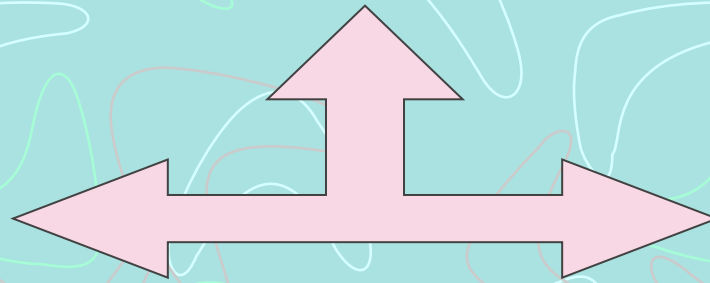
It is linked to knowledge as a way to understand the world, to become fully developed in it, and contribute to make our society better.
